Mr. Ehling,

As we discussed on the phone, our office will need you to address the fee waiver criteria before we will be able to make a determination on your fee waiver request. Please provide the additional information to Joe Willging at [REDACTED] (he is also CC'd on this email). Your Freedom of Information Act request will not be perfected until we receive additional clarification from you on the fee waiver issue.

During our phone conversation, we also discussed the potential refinement of your request and whether it may be possible to narrow the request based on categories of responsive documents. I also mentioned to you that with respect to internal agency documents it is likely that the bulk of those documents would be nearly entirely redacted under Exemption 5, and you indicated that you may consider eliminating that portion of the request after discussing it with Mr. Willging further next week.
