Jim, can we get the GoldSim model for Version 4, which would include revised Workplan data input tables, GoldSim model codes, and CV drawings, for reference/use by the ERM team (Marinelli)? I've come to understand this information is necessary in order for ERM to proceed with the site performance review.

Previously the model results (Version 3) have been posted to the Barr client access website. So, we're seeking the posting of the new models, results, and backup on the client access website as has been done in the past.

It is possible that Barr wants to wait until a new version of the model can be run that includes the revised surface water (SWIMM) results. This is understood. However, the Version 4 information is necessary now.
