I'll admit that I hadn't given any thought to actually getting comments on the model or model results.

For the spreadsheets containing model results, each comment should clearly identify the spreadsheet, the solute and the model evaluation location. If pertinent, it should also specify whether it relates to the annual maximum plots or the annual average plot.

For the model itself, the comment should provide a model location (container) and the element name. An example reference would be "\Project\Tailings_Basin\NorthMet_Basin\CELL_1E\Unsat_Fine\Depth_to_Zero_O2".
