David,

I talked with Erik this morning regarding QA of the Mine Site model. He will request that Barr send the updated work plan, data package, and model impact results (Peter's spreadsheets). We will also need an updated version of the GoldSim model that contains Peter's internal documentation.

Erik proposes a teleconference meeting with Barr on July 11 to go over the preliminaries for QA/QC. Most important here will be the identification of migration pathways that have the most significant effects on chemical concentrations in groundwater and the Partridge River. Previous results suggested that the most important chemical source is the Cat 1 Stockpile and most significant pathway is release from the West Pit into the West Pit Surficial Flowpath, which occurs when the West Pit floods above the bedrock rim. Migration in this flowpath was predicted to reach Partridge River Station 004a at about year 80.

With regard to the Plant Site, Erik asked that we address Barr responses to our Task 1 QA comments.
