Thank you to all of you who attend the LPR demo by Matt Maxwell of Remington ELSAG. I hope you found the demo useful. The CAPROP unit, through the auspices of the Auto Theft Grant, has committed to purchasing, installing, and using an LPR system and making it available to the Districts as a tool to fight auto theft as soon as the selection is made, contractual issues addressed, the various units involved are on-board as to time commitments, and the logistics can be worked out.


There were good questions asked at the demo that helped us clarify some of the issues. From the comments I heard, most of you realized the potential of the program.

I have sought a recommendation from the Office of the City Attorney on the data retention issues. I have also scheduled another meeting with the vendor and internal staff to clarify the server issue, and time commitments that may be required of the Systems staff.

I am also considering the issue of mobile v. fixed mounting to one car. I came away from the demo feeling that the mobile solution may be better with two squads from each district being loaded with the software to avoid problems should one or the other of the cars being placed out of service. What are your thoughts?
