Based on this incident reported under CN 09-255026, my guess is word of our use of the LPR is getting out. Please let officers know to be aware of and look for altered license plates covering the fact that the vehicle is stolen.

"...(the officer) was alerted to a suspicious appearance to the rear plate. I went over to look myself, and realized there was a fraudulent paper plate taped over the actual plate....The fraudulent plate appeared to be a picture of a real MN license plate, then printed off a computer. The front license plate was not attached to the front of the vehicle. It had been removed, a second fraudulent copy was made, and taped over the actual plate. This plate was placed in the front window covering the VIN # of the vehicle."
