I extend to you an invitation to conduct Urban Military Training in our City. Your letter requesting to train dated 7 January 2014 in the City of Saint Paul from 10-23 August, 2014 is approved. I understand that this training will include low visibility movement, military operations in urban terrain, manual, shotgun, and low weight explosive breaching, low-altitude precision helicopter operations to include hover, landing, and rooftop fast-rope insertions, live-fire, simmunition (paint), flash bang, surveillance and counter-surveillance operations.

Your planning team further indicated that the proposed training will be coordinated with and approved by the Saint Paul Police Department. I am confident that the detailed coordination taking place between members of your command and personnel from the Saint Paul Police Department will result in a safe and successful exercise. I understand that all liability for your personnel and their actions during training rests with the Navy. I ask that communication between your group and my office continue throughout the training period to keep all parties apprized of the events proposed for 10-23 August, 2014. I welcome the opportunity to support the United States Navy as you develop the techniques and tactics necessary to protect our country. Due to the sensitivities of this training, we will exclude the correspondence from automatic public release. We look forward to your group having a safe and productive training exercise in our City.
