Tonya, Chris, and Eric, thank you for supporting our event. To answer some questions you probably have to answer, there is an attached document which explains our insurance and indemnification. Additionally, I will explain how we will set up and control the site.

- RSO, command security personnel, and local police arrive at site and conduct walk through with property POC to discuss any last minute issues and to ensure we are the only individuals on site.
- Role players and exercise control group arrive and prepare for training.
- Site is set/secure and personnel arrive to conduct training. Local law enforcement will provide security at the site throughout the entire event.
- Training ends and site is cleaned.
- Government representative (usually me) conducts walk through with property POC to ensure site is left in satisfactory condition.
- Final walk through is conducted to ensure all personnel are off site and location is turned over to owner/locked.

Reference information:

- Dates of use are 18 – 22 August 2014. We have asked for these dates to give us some flexibility for unforeseen events. We will use the site during these dates for one or two days for approximately 4 to 5 hours each night (will coordinate with you as we get closer).
- Proposed activities are listed in paragraph five of the agreement.
- Safety - EMS personnel (or equivalent) will be on site.
- Operational Security: Share this information with only essential individuals. Our training event is NOT open to the public or press. We will coordinate with appropriate entities through our city/local law enforcement contacts.
- Information support: We will have personnel tied into the 911 center to answer queries and provide statements as necessary.

MISC: If you think of anything or have any questions get in touch with me or give me a time that is convenient for you and I will call. We will be in the Minneapolis/St Paul area over the next couple of months to continue our planning and can coordinate a date/time to answer any last minute questions. I have Ccd Tim Flynn our POC to the Saint Paul Police Department to let you know we are training with the city's full support. He can answer your questions as well.
