

**Minnesota PMAP+**  
Coverage Expansion Request Update

**Issue:** Minnesota would like to expand coverage to childless adults with income from 75 up to and including 250 percent of the FPL.

**Discussion:** On May 11<sup>th</sup>, the State indicated that it would agree to work with the State legislature to change the durational residency requirement for MinnesotaCare in State law, as well as to make the appropriate changes to its MMIS system to comply with Medicaid citizenship regulations and to ensure no FFP is claimed for any Demonstration participants that become incarcerated while enrolled in MinnesotaCare.

The State would like to have approximately 6 months to make the legislative and system changes outlined above. The State is proposing to submit claims for FFP beginning January 1, 2012. At that time, the State will also submit claims that have been incurred since July 1, 2011.
