Per our phone discussion, please find the second agreement principle letter to MN attached. I used our previous letter as a template, and made minor changes given the fact that the only thing that has changed is the upper FPL limit. I also kept our language that the State must remove the durational residency requirement before we move forward. The Legislature still needs to make this change as of today. I believe the Governor needs this subsequent letter as he continues to negotiate with the Legislature to pass the State's operating budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1.
