Dear Mr. Ehling:

You appealed from the action of the Headquarters Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation on your request for access to records concerning video surveillance of the Pentagon on September 11, 2001.

After carefully considering your appeal, I have decided to affirm the initial action in this case.

The FBI properly withheld this information because it is protected from disclosure pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)(A). This provision concerns records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, the release of which could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings. This material is not appropriate for discretionary release.

If you are dissatisfied with my action on your appeal, you may seek judicial review in accordance with 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(B).
