Dear Mr. Ehling:

You appealed from the action of the Headquarters Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation on your request for access to records concerning video surveillance of Marine Corps Headquarters on September 11, 2001.

As per our conversation on April 20, 2003, on April 9, 2003, our Office mistakenly forwarded a letter to you affirming the FBI's initial decision to withhold records pursuant to Exemption 7(A). Alternatively, our letter should have advised you that after discussions between the FBI and a member of my staff, the FBI conducted a search for video surveillance of Marine Corps Headquarters on September 11, 2001. Please be advised that this search failed to locate records. I sincerely apologize any inconvenience you may have experienced as a result of our error.

As we advised in our letter of April 9, 2003, if you are dissatisfied with my action on your appeal, you may seek judicial review in accordance with 5 U.S.C. -§ 552(a)(4)(B).
