If any significant civil rights violation cases develop as a result of Secure Flight's implementation, the National Archives will receive these case files from the Department of Homeland Security's Civil Rights and Civil Liberties Office via Records Disposition Schedule Job No. N1-563-07-6 Items 1b3 and 2c. In addition, all TSA case files regarding significant litigation are scheduled as permanent via Records Disposition Schedule Job No. N1-563-08-1 Item 6.

Normally, we afford commenters 15 working days to reply to our initial response to their comments. However, in light of exigent circumstances regarding the program's implementation date, we would request that any further comments be received by us before close of business on January 23, 2009.
