The above-entitled matter came on for hearing before the undersigned Judge of District Court on the 28th day of April, 2006, on Defendants' Motion to Dismiss pursuant to Chapter 554. Gregory J. Walsh, Esq. appeared on behalf of Defendants; Steven H. Siltan, Esq. appeared on behalf of Plaintiffs.

Based upon all the files, records and proceedings herein, together with the arguments of counsel, the Court hereby orders as follows:

1. Defendants' Motion to Dismiss is granted;
2. Plaintiffs' claims against Defendants are dismissed with prejudice;
3. Defendants are entitled to the attorneys fees and costs associated with the bringing of the motion to dismiss pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 554.04, subd. 1. The amount of such attorneys fees and costs shall be verified by affidavit of Defendants' attorneys and thereafter judgment shall be entered in Defendants' favor for such reasonable attorneys fees and costs; and,
4. Defendants are entitled to an award of actual damages and punitive damages pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 554.04, subd. 2 (a) & (b). The amount of such actual damages shall be

verified by affidavit of Defendants' attorneys and thereafter judgment shall be entered in Defendants' favor for such damages. The amount of punitive damages shall be determined in accordance with Minn. Stat. § 549.20.
