The Minnesota Department of Human Services (DHS) has completed the evaluation of the responses to the Request for Proposals (RFP) issued April 4, 2011. The Medica proposal to provide health care services to eligible recipients of Medical Assistance and MinnesotaCare includes Anoka, Carver, Dakota, Hennepin, Ramsey, Scott and Washington counties.

This letter is to inform you that upon completion of the evaluation process, the State has selected another Responder(s) to enter into contract negotiations to meet the State's needs for Anoka, Carver, Dakota, Ramsey, Scott and Washington counties. In accordance with the RFP, until the State successfully completes negotiations with the selected Responder(s), all submitted proposals remain eligible for selection by the State.
