I am requesting access to government data under the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act (Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 13). Through this request, I am seeking to inspect and/or copy public data created, produced, received, maintained, or disseminated between January 1, 2014 and November 1, 2015 related to the following public data:

- Any and all correspondence between the staff of the St. Paul mayor's office and representatives of Major League Soccer related to the locating of a soccer stadium at/near Interstate 94 and Snelling Avenue.
- Any and all correspondence between the staff of the St. Paul mayor's office and Bill McGuire and/or his representatives related to the locating of a soccer stadium at/near Interstate 94 and Snelling Avenue.
- Any and all correspondence between the staff of the St. Paul Port Authority and representatives of Major League Soccer related to the locating of a soccer stadium at/near Interstate 94 and Snelling Avenue.
- Any and all correspondence between the staff of the St. Paul Port Authority and Bill McGuire and/or his representatives related to the locating of a soccer stadium at/near Interstate 94 and Snelling Avenue.
- Any and all correspondence between the staff of the St. Paul Port Authority and representatives of Major League Soccer and/or Bill McGuire and/or his representatives regarding ancillary development near the soccer stadium.

If responsive data are found, I would first like the opportunity to inspect such data, prior to identifying specific sub-sets of data to copy.

Please consider this letter a formal request for the indefinite retention of the requested data, pending the resolution of its status.


As required by section 13.03, Subd. 3(f) of the Minnesota Statutes, I am requesting that in the event that any portion of my request is not granted, you certify in writing that the
