Dear FOIA staff,

This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. § 552). I request that copies of the following records be provided to me:

1. Any and all incident reports (or similar documentation) related to the death of United States Supreme Court Justice Antonin Scalia;
2. Any and all correspondence - in both written and electronic form - created, transmitted, or received by members of your agency that pertains to the death of United States Supreme Court Justice Antonin Scalia, including correspondence that documents your agency's response to the incident.

In order to help you determine my status for the purpose of assessing fees, you should know that this request is made as part of news gathering, and is not for commercial use. Responsive records will be shared with researchers, journalists, and the public, and will not be licensed for profit.

I am seeking a waiver of fees for this request, since the public dissemination of the requested materials will aid the public's understanding of the government's response to reports of Justice Scalia's passing, and will add to the historical record.


If my fee waiver is denied, I am willing to pay fees of up to \$100.00 without prior notice. If fees as estimated to exceed this amount, please notify me first.
