I sent the following e-mail to the FAA. Your support of my concern would be appreciated.

"On 8-18-14 between 9:30 PM and 10:30 PM our neighborhood north of MSP was overflowed four times by four two-seat helicopters flying at low altitude in close formation. At least on one fly-over they were accompanied by two Blackhawk-sized helicopters. Besides making a racket each time, they put the residential neighborhoods at risk; a collision of two or more helicopters flying in close formation could have caused several deaths on the ground. Close flying exercises should be done over sparsely populated areas, not over one of the heaviest populated area of the state."
