Please disregard my previous statement about parking being allowed in loading zones outside of times stated on signs. I just had an internal discussion and we changed our sign message when the new meters were installed to make the message more clear (see attached policy for example). The intention is that it is NO PARKING except Commercial Vehicles may park during designated time for loading. Outside of that time and for everyone else it is NO PARKING and any parked vehicle is subject to a citation. Police Parking Enforcement has been given the message to enforce as described. I apologize for the confusion.

None of the codes I reference before state this explicitly. I have attached them for reference.
