Your questions have been directed to me. Please see my answers below (in red). Thank you.

St. Paul Port Authority --

I wanted to get back to something we discussed about a month ago (see below).

I was interested in finding out who the owners of the incoming Major League Soccer team will be. Dr. Bill McGuire of course has mostly been the front person for the team, but there had been earlier reports that members of the Pohlad family, Glen Taylor and other prominent Minnesotans would also be owners.

This information has not yet been disclosed.

I was asking you the earlier questions to see if the Port Authority had received any indications who the owners might be. Your answer from last month were self explanatory.

We are in addition going to ask Minnesota United the same questions, but wanted to also again approach the Port Authority.

Here's my questions:

-- Are there are any signed documents so far between the Port Authority (or the city) and the Team? Your earlier answer indicated there were not, but I wanted to make sure.

There are no signed documents at this time.

-- If there are signed documents, who is signing them for the team?

-- And, during the many meetings the Port Authority has had on the stadium project, who is in the room representing the team? Is it Dr. McGuire and several subordinates? Others?

Only Dr. McGuire and his legal representatives have represented the team.

-- Has Dr. McGuire indicated he will be the sole owner of the team? The majority owner? Has he said specifically what his role will be?

He has only hinted that there will be others; no names have been discussed.
