On 11/7/65 the Vietnam Day Committee held a Steering Committee meeting at 2407 Fulton Street, Berkeley. The main part of the discussion was the November 20th march. MARV DAVIDOV made the suggestion that the march should be a completely non-violent one. He stated even if someone batters one of the marchers, they should not fight back. Many people were in disagreement with this thought.
