On or about December 5th, 2016, the Hennepin County Sheriff's Office received your request pursuant to the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act. Specifically you requested:

"Public data created, produced, received, maintained, or disseminated related to the following:

1. From Nov. 1, 2016 to Nov. 30, 2016, all correspondence, including emails and texts, from Sheriff Rich Stanek and sheriff's office staff members regarding deployment of sheriff's office personnel to North Dakota over the Dakota Access Pipeline issue.
2. Since the deployment of sheriff's office personnel began, a list of all Sheriff's Office equipment taken to North Dakota as part of the Dakota Access Pipeline issue."

Pursuant to the terms of the Emergency Management Assistance Compact (EMAC), any requests regarding the EMAC should be directed to the Minnesota Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, a division of the Minnesota Department of Public Safety, at 651-201-7400; as they are the responsible and releasing authority for the information requested.

In accordance with the terms of the MN-EMAC agreement, any requests regarding correspondence or emails relating to the MN-EMAC operation must also be approved by the Minnesota Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management.
