Thanks for your message. On background, here is information relating to your questions:

-Twenty-nine Hennepin County Sheriff's Deputies were deployed to Morton County, North Dakota, along with six deputies from Anoka and five deputies from Washington Counties, as part of an Emergency Assistance Management Compact between the states of North Dakota and Minnesota. The Hennepin County deputies were deployed from Oct. 23 through Nov. 1, 2016.

-There have been no resignations of HCSO personnel related to mutual aid operations in North Dakota.
