To All Sheriffs & Chief Deputies:

I sent out this update on Tuesday March 28th and just learned that some of you may not have seen this, due to a “hang up” in our MSA server on our end.....Sorry about that.....Here is a

very quick update over the past 48 hours on this issue.....

- 1 ICE has issued new forms see notice info below. The fact still remains that many County Attorneys and the ACLU do not believe the new ICE forms are a valid arrest and reason to continue to hold for ICE.
- 2 ACLU has been sending their letter to every LE agency in the country and in many cases visiting the LE CLEO to press their point on these ICE hold issues
- 3 I have sent a CC of ACLU "Cheap Shot" letter to Lexipol for their review and comment. To me the attack by ACLU on Lexipol tells me there is more right than wrong in the respective Lexipol Policy.
- 4 To their Credit Lexipol has reached out to ACLU for a meeting to discuss and review their concerns and or differences in interpretation of the policies.
- 5 Finally, Sheriff Stanek has been in DC for the past couple of days meeting with the President, Atty General and other Homeland Security and ICE officials. He has reported that additional Judges are being hired to process these ICE orders, which will give them the appropriate "Judicial" signature.....
- 6 So hopefully some additional progress will be made in this area.....FYI.....thanks....jimf....MSA.....

To All Sheriffs & Chief Deputies:

Yesterday I received a phone call from Scott Baniecke who gave me a heads up that a new ICE memo and form were coming out and would be effective April 2nd. See e-mail message below. As you can see all previous forms will now be replaced with this new 247A form and you will see the attached I-200 and I-205 from they will also be using. It is my understanding that usually when a Sheriff receives a 247A form a I-200 or I-205 form will be attached. However is possible the I-200/205 forms may come later after the initial receipt of the 247A form.

While ICE says this is a legal hold, most County Attorneys are saying NO.....and of course the ACLU is running all over the country providing their guidance and notice to Sheriffs with the expressed intent of future law suits.....

Fast forward to the link below where the White House is proposing LE loose funding if they do not support their immigration policies.....Absolut no win for Sheriffs???? Please consult with your respective County Attorney and don't be surprised when the political correctness feedback comes from all sides on this issue.....Thanks...jimf.....MSA.....
