Hi Louis & Alan - Some updates, etc. ...

(1) As discussed, we sent a proposed June 13th itinerary to our special guest's office yesterday. Our request included a 10-minute segment for the two of you to meet with him along with Governor Walker.

Today, the Governor's staff had a couple of conversations with the guest's staff about various aspects of the itinerary and your meeting was specifically pointed out to them. Although we have not received final confirmation, our sense is the itinerary will go

through as requested, including your meeting. Having said that, I am not sure when we might receive a "final" confirmation (or if we will ever receive a "final" one) prior to the 13th.

As I mentioned in my conversation with Louis and my subsequent email to both of you, I believe there is merit in your going through with the meeting. Certainly, the decision is up to you, but Governor Walker is pleased to make the opportunity available to you and will respect whatever you decide. Please let me know what you would like to do. Should you decide to travel to Milwaukee for the meeting, I would propose you arrive the evening of the 12th. Scott and I could then meet with you the morning of the 13th and start our weekly conversations in person.

- (2) Because he will be returning from an international trip early in the week, Rep. James Sensenbrenner is only able to meet with you Wednesday, June 21st, which would require you to stay an additional day in D.C. Rep. Sensenbrenner is the senior member of the Wisconsin delegation having first been elected to the U.S. Congress in 1978. He serves on the Judiciary and also the Foreign Affairs committees in the U.S. House of Representatives.

He is an influential member of Congress and I believe his experience would be helpful. But since he is not available until the morning of the 21st (we would meet before 10 a.m. EDT), I wanted to check to see if you could stay the additional day. Fyi, the request for Speaker Ryan has not been acted on yet. But I have been told the likely day would be on Tuesday if his able to meet. Let me know if you can meet with Rep. Sensenbrenner on Wed, 6/21, and I will confirm it with his office.

- (3) Finally, as Louis and Scott have discussed, our standing meetings on Tuesday mornings @ 7 a.m. CDT will be via teleconference. Please provide a contact name for our tech person to reach out to get the mechanics in place.

Please let me know if you have any questions. Thank you and we look forward to continuing the conversation. - Mark
