Thanks for the voice message. Yes, you may share the talking points, but please use the following, as there was another modification as of late yesterday (aligning with the information in the PUC filing documents). Also, it is my understanding the PUC filing is expected to be made today at 3PM. It would be most helpful if the local officials say nothing until the PUC filing is complete, to ensure we are in compliance with the NDA. I understand and appreciate how rumors go around, but it is best for us to not get too far ahead of the client. We certainly hope this gets us one step closer to an announcement. We cannot stress that the PUC filing is not a final decision from the client. This is one step in many towards a potential final decision.

I've cc'd Dan Pfeiffer on this message if you have other questions or if he wishes to comment. And, feel free to let the elected officials know if they would prefer to have DEED respond to questions – they can defer to Shane Delaney, our Communications Director.
