I am an active member of Mill City Commons, an organization with about 200 members who live near the Mississippi. Mill City Commons is a "village" organization providing educational, cultural, and physical programs and resources to enable members to "age in place." We have a rich program calendar of presentations on various issues. (That's a rather inadequate description of the organization, but I hope it gives you a picture of the richness of the organization.)

Our members, which include a number of lawyers, some of whom graduated from the U, as well as former Vice President Mondale and a member of the Board of Regents would like to talk with Richard Painter about meeting with Mill City Commons members to discuss the ethical issues related to President Trump's businesses and actions.
