

- Are buildings being switched to "unoccupied" ventilation mode? If so, who makes that decision and do they know if essential research is occurring in those spaces? How is that decision communicated to the occupants of that building?
- How do we navigate the temptation to bring research materials home? What is allowed and what isn't? From a health and safety perspective, no chemicals or biologicals should be brought home, but what about equipment? Should this be included in the next OVPR e-mail blast?

Upcoming activities, things you are preparing for:

- Remote meetings with our service partners to answer questions, discuss essential operations, discuss extended closure (College of Pharmacy, Joint Safety Team, etc.)
- Design/creation of a "Notice of Operation" for essential labs to post so facility staff know someone is operating in that space and can maintain proper social distancing/stay out if hazardous work is being conducted.
- FYI food service at res halls still housing and feeding students is being conducted under the following enhanced food safety operating protocols:

Sanitarian:

- 1) Serving utensils in buffet lines are being exchanged with cleaned and sanitized replacements at 20 minute intervals during service periods.
- 2) In addition to normal prescriptive handwashing, food staff has been directed by management to conduct regular hand washes at 15 minute intervals.
