A physical surveillance was conducted at the weekly public protest by ALLIANT ACTION (AA) at the Alliant Techsystems (ATK) Corporate Headquarters in Edina, Minnesota. Approximately 35 demonstrators attended the protest and no arrests were conducted by the Edina Police Department.

The following comments were overheard by TFA [redacted] [redacted] (ATK employee) and [redacted] (It should be noted that the overheard was accomplished by the protest parties using a megaphone to make their statements. A lawnmower was in use during the protest making the overheard difficult).

1) At or around 7:35 a.m., the protesting parties became audible over the megaphone.

2) An unknown female advises that an elderly male associate is disturbed by three "beeping" phone-calls that he received in a period of two hours. She speculated that these "beeps" could be terrorists communicating via Morse Code. She then mentioned that another member of the audience suggested the "beeps" could be caused by a fax machine.

3) A female who identified herself as [redacted] indicated that she had reserved four rooms at the Hampton Inn for use during the "School of Americas Protest" outside Fort Benning, Georgia.

4) An unknown female indicated that on Saturday, September 24, 2005, a march was planned at ATK similar to the Washington DC march planned for that same day.

5) An unknown female indicated that Coldwater Camp is close due to its violation of two federal laws.

6) An unknown female declared that Sisters representing nine orders of Sisters presented a proposal at ATK's August 2, 2005, shareholders meeting. The proposal asked ATK to consider the ethical consequences of weapons sales and because it passed with a 6% vote, the proposal will be re-considered at the 2006 shareholders meeting.

7) An unknown female mentioned regret over concluding the shareholders protest early because the meeting ended approximately 10 minutes after their departure. She explained that they were "sweating bullets" in the heat.

8) At approximately 8:05 a.m., the protesting parties started to sing and subsequently departed the area.
