Jessica –

You asked how the “at or below 275 percent of the FPL or \$50,000 per year (whichever is lower)” income limit is applied to MinnesotaCare Caretaker adults.

First, income is calculated for the household using the MinnesotaCare gross income test (see e.g. STC 17). If the annual household income for the relevant family size is at or below 275% FPG, children through age 20 in the household are eligible for MinnesotaCare. If the caretaker adults’ MinnesotaCare gross income does not exceed \$50,000, the caretaker adults are eligible. If it exceeds \$50,000, they are not eligible.

I hope this explanation is helpful.
