Dear Chief Judge Davis:

I write in connection with Plaintiff's Response to Defendant's Objections to the Magistrate's Order, which was filed on the Court's docket on February 25, 2013. In that response, Plaintiff seeks for the first time to submit its own objection to the magistrate's order regarding attorney's fees and has submitted additional "documentation" in support of that objection. *See* Dkt. #34 at 7. Specifically, Plaintiff has submitted a document captioned "Haines/PRM Invoice," which purports to detail the hours Plaintiff's counsel spent in litigating this matter. *See* Dkt. #34-2.

This is the first time the Government has seen this purported "documentation." As the Government explained in its objections, Plaintiff did not submit any documentation in support of its motion for attorney's fees before the magistrate judge. Plaintiff failed to do so even after the Government pointed out this deficiency in its opposition brief. Accordingly, the Government respectfully requests the Court's leave to file a short reply of no more than five pages addressing Plaintiff's objection and additional "documentation."
