FYI - I received a call from CM Dorfman this morning with questions on the pedestrian bridge. She mostly asked questions regarding engineering detail i.e. how tall is the bridge, how long is the bridge, etc. She stated that unlike the other CMs, she did not understand the need for the bridge and why crossings couldn't be managed at street level by additional MTPD and others at a much lower cost.
