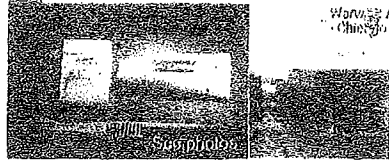

For more than forty years, Peter W. Smith has directed private equity firms. From 1997 to 2014, Mr. Smith, as Managing Member of DigaComm, LLC, led or co-led fifteen early-stage venture investments, including iPIX and L-90, Inc.. He was President of Peter W. Smith & Company, Inc. from 1975 to 1997, a firm that led twelve buyout transactions, including Donnelly Marketing, Inc. and Hunter-Melnor, Inc. Previously, Mr. Smith was a senior officer of Field Enterprises, Inc., a diversified communications company held by the Marshall Field family.

Mr. Smith's involvement with public affairs includes twelve years with the Atlantic Council of the United States as Board Vice Chair, Treasurer, and Finance Chairman. He served as National Chairman of the College Young Republicans, and was involved with fundraising for GOPAC as well as candidate and state party organizations. The focus of his national political campaign activity since 1992 has been on independent expenditures, including Troopergate disclosures involving President Clinton.

Mr. Smith, 81, resided in Lake Forest, Illinois, and is survived by his wife, Janet L. Smith, three children Linda S. Ransom, William M. Smith, David A. Smith and three grandchildren.

(Illinois Compiled Statutes, 755 ILCS 35/1 et seq.)

DECLARATION

This declaration is made this 29th day of MARCH, 2017 (month, year).

I, Peter W. Smith being of sound mind, willfully and voluntarily make known my desires that my moment of death shall not be artificially postponed.

If at any time I should have an incurable and irreversible injury, disease, or illness judged to be a terminal condition by my attending physician who has personally examined me and has determined that my death is imminent except for death delaying procedures, I direct that such procedures which would only prolong the dying process be withheld or withdrawn, and that I be permitted to die naturally with only the administration of medication, sustenance, or the performance of any medical procedure deemed necessary by my attending physician to provide me with comfort care.

In the absence of my ability to give directions regarding the use of such death delaying procedures, it is my intention that this declaration shall be honored by my family and physician as the final expression of my legal right to refuse medical or surgical treatment and accept the consequences from such refusal.
