To followup on your inquiry -- our plan for tomorrow is to:

- Announce the Foxconn construction of a state-of-the-art Gen 10.5 manufacturing facility for the production of LCD panel products in Wisconsin, with potential for growth to other states.
- Further highlight that:
 - Foxconn and Wisconsin will sign a Memorandum of Understanding on Thursday (July 27) in Milwaukee.
 - Foxconn will start immediately to set up initial capabilities in Southern Wisconsin while the larger campus is constructed over a 2.5 year period.
 - There will be an initial \$10B investment creating 3,000 jobs, which has the potential to grow to 13,000 jobs
