Hi Mark and Scott,

It was great to see you guys last couple of weeks in Milwaukee and in D.C. Again thanks for the lovely dinner at Hilton, Milwaukee and the "private" meeting with Big Boss and the meetings with the Wisconsin congressional delegation in D.C.

Terry likes to thank Governor Walker for the box of wild and cultivated ginseng and the lovely box hand-made by a local Wisconsin artist. Terry is very touched by Governor Walker's token of friendship.

We are working on Terry's upcoming trip to visit Wisconsin. He plans to arrive in late July 9 to have two and half full working days with Governor Walker and his team on both July 10 and 11 before leaving in the early afternoon of July 12.

In those two and half days, we will like to accomplish the following objectives.

1. Have Governor Walker and Terry put the final touches on the 818 or 868 proposal from Wisconsin to Foxconn. The timing will be perfect if both Governor Walker and Terry can jointly approve a "definitive" agreement between Wisconsin and Foxconn to establish the TFT LCD fab as the critical component to build out a complete ecosystem of advanced display manufacturing

industry in Wisconsin.

2. Before the completion of the building of 818 or 868, Terry likes to start with the manufacturing of the backend modules with the Open Cell (glasses) to be shipped from Japan/Taiwan/mainland China and final assembly of whole sets including mechanical parts and etc. That can create jobs and revenue almost immediately if we can rent out a temporary facility before a permanent facility of backend modules and final assembly is built and outfitted within a year.
3. Terry likes to elaborate and strategize with Governor Walker his vision of transforming Wisconsin's traditional manufacturing sector with (+Internet) with cloud computing, mobile devices, IoT, big data, smart solutions, Internet with robots. In a way, Terry wants to build a most advanced Industry 4.0 manufacturing industry for the display market in Wisconsin equipped with the full supply chain. That is historic and that is exciting and that is certainly transformational to the economic structure of Wisconsin.
4. In those few days, will Speaker Ryan be back? It will be wonderful to walk the proposed sites with Speaker Ryan in his district and it will be great if we can set up a dinner with both the Governor and the Speaker during Terry's visit to let Terry thank the Speaker for [REDACTED] and to get to know the Speaker in person.

6. Work out with Gale and his team on the deployment of 8K ecosystem in the new Milwaukee Bucks auditorium.
7. Discuss concrete working partnership with Rockwell Automation on industrial computing, sensor and etc.
8. Build new data centers in Wisconsin given the incoming buildup of digital video data demanded by big data collection, analysis and usage.

Can you and your team put together an itinerary for Terry to have not only productive and meaningful discussions with the relevant parties while he visits your great state but together with Governor Walker to jointly approve a definitive agreement with Wisconsin on either 818 or 868 and its subsequent supply chain in downstream as a transformational and historic ecosystem in Wisconsin?

The challenge facing us before Terry's visit to Wisconsin is to "finalize" the proposal from Wisconsin to Foxconn so that only final

touches need to be ironed out between Governor Walker and Terry.
Look forward to very exciting two weeks ahead of us.
