We really can't remove the supporting documents accompanied with application/STA when the processing is completed. One option is to rescind the STA completely and remove the entire grant from the system and have you re-file. If you decided to take this route, you will have to submit a confidentiality request letter (CFR 47, Part 0.459(b)) with the supporting documents to keep the confidential exhibit hidden. Nevertheless, the STA will have to go through coordination process again and you are looking at least 14-20 days for the STA to be reviewed and approved.

Please bear in mind, the parameters on the grant (frequency, emission, location, power) will still be viewable to public.
