Dear Mr. Kaszuba:


I am responding to your recent data request asking to inspect correspondence between Sherburne County officials and Google, DEED and the City of Becker regarding a potential data center, and any non-disclosure agreements relating to the potential project. That data has been compiled and is available for inspection and copying at the County Administrator's Office during normal County business hours. Alternatively, since the data is stored electronically in various formats, we can copy it to a flash drive and either mail it to you or make it available for you to pick up. The cost for the flash drive is \$5.00, plus any mailing costs if you wish to receive the data by mail.

The compiled data includes all of the responsive data with the exception of the following:

1. Data not available for inspection pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 13.393; and
2. A single document classified as trade secret pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 13.37. (We provided as much data as we could, however, so if an email included an attachment with trade secret data, we removed the attachment but provided the email.)
