By this time, you have likely seen the update from President Gabel indicating that classes will be moving to alternative instruction for the remainder of the semester. We recognize that this news may create questions for many of you regarding your living space on campus at UMD.

As indicated in the President's message, housing facilities will remain available for those students that absolutely need them. If you do not need to be on campus, we expect that you will complete your coursework from home. **Students must move out of their housing by 8 PM on Sunday March 22, 2020.** Information regarding move out is below.

Please note that we may need to consolidate students to a smaller number of facilities to streamline operations. If you need to stay on campus, you may need to move to another housing facility - more information on this process will be shared at a later date.

HOUSING INFORMATION DESK

The Housing Information Desk in the Lake Superior Hall Lobby will be open daily from 8 AM - 8 PM. The primary service of the information desk will be to facilitate check outs. We are no longer facilitating check out of items such as movies, sports equipment, or cooking utensils.

If you would like to collect your items and move out of your room or apartment, you may do so. Your room and building keys will allow you to gain access to your area - note that exterior doors will likely be locked, so you will need to bring your keys!
