Dear Myron,

I've learned from our team that you already received and returned a new OIGI Advisory Board contract. Thank you for being willing to continue your service to the Institute this way. However, due to a communication lapse on my part, our team sent you a three year contract. I had intended to send you a contract with a one year term. This is part of my conversion of the Board to rotating three year terms, something I discussed in our fall Advisory Board call and summarized in the follow up notes to that call. A number of other Advisors will also be receiving one year contracts, and others two. The new contract length has no bearing on future renewal invitations. I only want to move us to a system where we do not have to renew all contracts every year.

My apologies for this error. Brad from our team will void the earlier contract and send a new contract with the correct term length.
