Dear Professor Zhang,

Huawei Technologies Co., Ltd. is pleased to make an unrestricted, charitable gift of \$60,000 to the University of Minnesota Foundation to support your research in the field of future content distribution networks and related research areas, who shall be the sole beneficiary of this gift.

The gift will be available in two (2) installments for expenses related to the research. The first installment of \$30,000 will be paid with the issuance of this Gift Letter, within 30 days after receiving the invoice. The second installment of \$30,000 will be paid six (6) months after the date of this letter within 30 days after receiving the invoice.

All taxes levied on the University of Minnesota or Huawei shall be borne by either Party respectively in accordance with the applicable tax laws and/or regulations. It is clearly agreed and understood by parties that China withholding tax levied on this Gift Letter is zero. If required by the laws of People's Republic of China, Huawei shall have the right to deduct any taxes imposed in the People's Republic of China on any payment to be made by Huawei to the University of Minnesota. In that case, the University of Minnesota shall only be paid by Huawei the balance after such deduction from the gift. Upon the University of Minnesota's request, Huawei shall submit to the University of Minnesota official taxes receipts as such. If changes in China tax law and regulation require tax withholding resulting in a reduction of the gift paid to the University of Minnesota, Huawei will cooperate with the University of Minnesota in consideration of a supplemental gift agreement to maintain the original intended funding.

Huawei makes no claims on the basis of this gift to any ownership or other beneficial interest in any work product resulting from this gift. Nonetheless, we would appreciate being kept abreast of the progress of the research and request that you provide us with an annual progress report or as is otherwise appropriate.
